Shanks offer leverage and neck reining capability with the use of only one hand. Choosing the right mouthpiece and shank length enables riders to more effectively communicate with their horses whether they are aiming high for the top of the standings or shooting for a well balanced horse in the home arena.






Chain with Copper Links **KLB-101**




Dogbone and Copper Rings **KLB-102**
